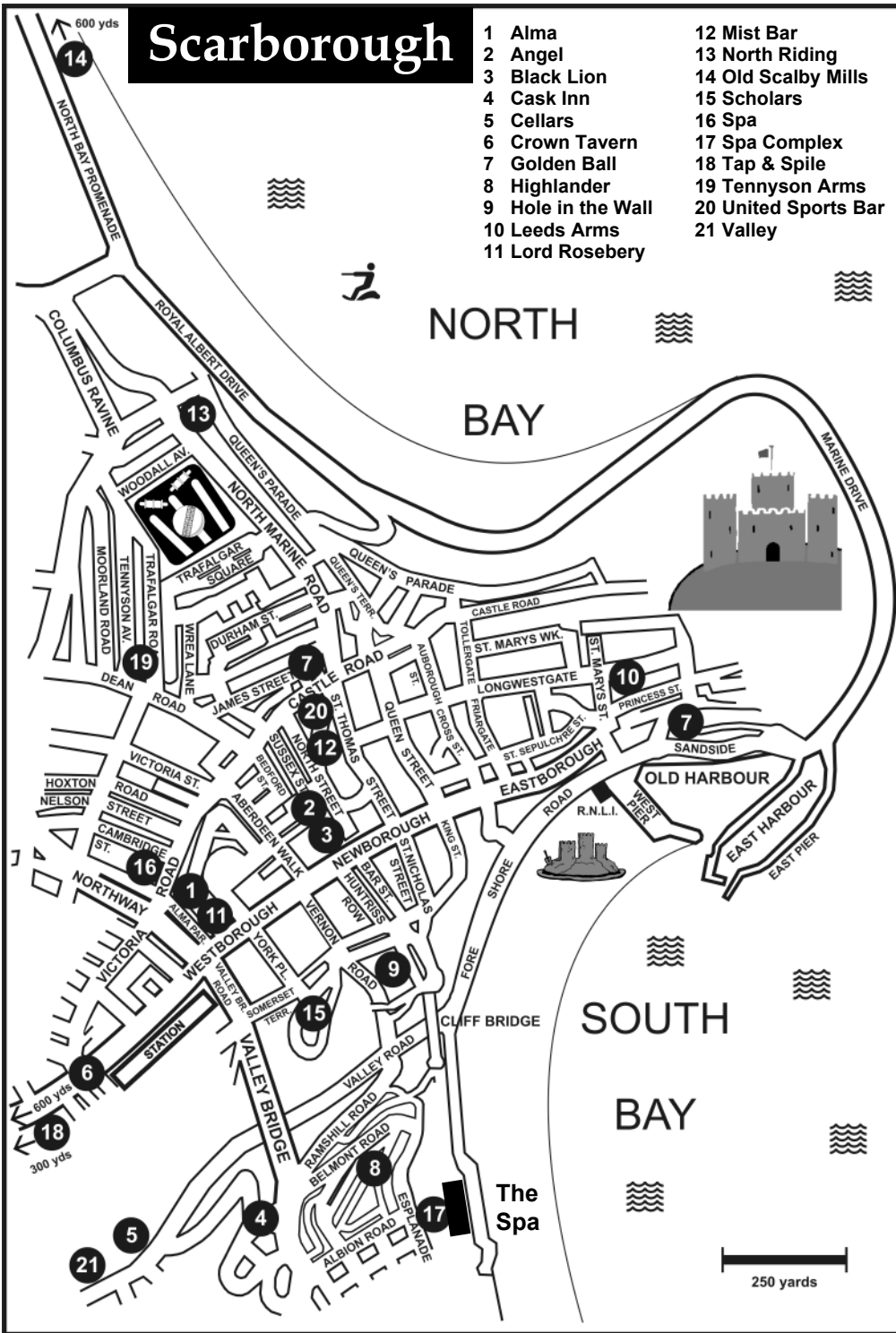

ALMA

Alma Parade (map ref 1)
Tetley's Cask; a Theakston beer; guest beers
 Cosy, busy, three-roomed pub near railway station and shopping centre. Lunchtime food.

ANGEL

North Street (map ref 2)
John Smith's Cask; Tetley's Cask; Wells Bombardier; guest beers
 Small and friendly, one-roomed, locals' pub in the heart of the town. Collection of 'saucy seaside' postcards on display.

BLACK LION

Chapmans Yard (map ref 3)
Up to 4 Marston's-supplied beers
 Friendly, centrally-located, two-roomed pub, popular with locals and shoppers. Sun-trap garden, pub games and excellent jukebox. Children and dogs welcome.

CASK INN

Cambridge Terrace (map ref 4)
Theakston & Wold Top beers
 Large, comfortable, multi-roomed pub at south end of Valley Bridge.

CELLARS

35 Valley Road (map ref 5)
Beers from Black Sheep & Durham; guest beers
 Family-run pub in the cellars of an elegant Victorian building converted to holiday flats. Wooden-floored bar and comfortable lounge with bar meals, plus à la carte restaurant. Live music Saturday evening.

CROWN TAVERN

8 Scalby Road (map ref 6)
Marston's Burton Bitter & Pedigree; 2 other Marston's-supplied beers
 A very well run, spacious Marston's 'Tavern' with a large car park. Reasonably-priced beer, and the food, served from 12-8 daily, includes special deals. Families welcome.

GOLDEN BALL

31 Sandside (map ref 7)
Samuel Smith's OBB
 Only Sam's in town. Can get very busy in summer.

HIGHLANDER

Esplanade (map ref 8)
Flowers IPA; Hancock's HB; Tetley's Cask; guest beers
 Busy and welcoming, one-roomed pub with patio overlooking South Bay. Very impressive range of malt whiskies and extensive tartan decor throughout. Lunchtime meals including carvery.

HOLE IN THE WALL

Vernon Road (map ref 9)
Jennings Cumberland Ale; other Marston's-supplied beers
 Split-level pub handy for the shops and South Bay beach. Formerly a renowned free house and the 'spiritual' home of Scarborough CAMRA. After years of flux, it's much improved and worth a visit if in the centre of town.

LEEDS ARMS

St. Mary's Street (map ref 10)
Draught Bass; Tetley's Cask; guest beers
 A gem – an unspoilt, one-roomed pub nestling in the old town. Fishing and lifeboat memorabilia.

LORD ROSEBERY

85 Westborough (map ref 11)
Greene King Abbot Ale; Marston's Pedigree; Theakston Best Bitter; guest beers

Typical Wetherspoon's outlet on two levels in a Victorian building. Food served all day.

MIST BAR

66 St. Thomas Street (map ref 12)
Caledonian Deuchars IPA
 Formerly the Equestrian, now a popular, modern 'style' bar with real ale alongside the continental lagers. Meals until early evening.

NORTH RIDING

North Marine Road (map ref 13)
Taylor Landlord; York Guzzler; 3 guest beers
 Reopened in 2005 by award-winning licensees previously at the Cricketers. Bar with large-screen TV, quiet lounge and dining room in which bar meals and Sunday lunches are served. Beer festivals a feature. Local CAMRA Pub of the Year 2008 & 2009.

OLD SCALBY MILLS

Scalby Mills Road (map ref 14)
Copper Dragon Black Gold; Wold Top Premium; 4 guest beers
 Historic, 500-year old building – formerly a water mill – with fine views across North Bay. Popular with walkers on the Cleveland Way, and worth the short hike from town.

SCHOLARS

Somerset Terrace (map ref 15)
Durham, Fernandes & Ossett beers; Copper Dragon Golden Pip-pin; Theakston Black Bull
 Spacious, multi-roomed pub, home of Scarborough Jazz Club. Live music Tue. Food served until early evening.

SPA

45 Victoria Road (map ref 16)
Tetley's Cask; guest beers
 Cosy, friendly pub catering for all ages. Quiz Wednesday eve.

SPA COMPLEX

South Bay (map ref 17)
Wold Top beers; occasional guest beers
 Real ale in the Buffet Bar amongst the Victorian splendour of the Spa complex, with outdoor seating and superb views across South Bay to the castle. The open top bus runs from here to the old Corner Cafe site for easy access to North side pubs.

TAP & SPILE

94 Falsgrave Road (map ref 18)
Beer range varies; cider
 Previously a coaching inn, it has three separate rooms and a large patio. Good value food. Live music.

TENNYSON ARMS

Dean Road (map ref 19)
Black Sheep Ale; Tetley's Cask
 Two-roomed local featuring traditional pub games.

UNITED SPORTS BAR

94 St. Thomas Street (map ref 20)
Black Sheep Ale; John Smith's Cask; Wells Bombardier
 Formerly the United Bus Co social club, now fully refurbished as a first-floor sports bar. Pool, darts, TV and gaming machines. Access from the street is via stairs at the rear.

VALLEY

51 Valley Road (map ref 21)
Theakston Best Bitter; 5 guest beers; up to 8 ciders
 Basement pub with split-level interior. CAMRA National Cider Pub of the Year 2007. Yorkshire Regional Cider Pub of the Year 2009. Local CAMRA Town Pub of the Year 2005 & 2007. Various entertainments, including monthly, themed beer and cider festivals throughout the Autumn and Winter. Good choice of Belgian beers, plus quality ciders, from small producers, for enthusiasts.
